SafeOps - Smart Safe Management

Our team set out to replace an aging safe management platform that was previously built on top of Microsoft Silverlight. This platform was engineered to support 900-1000 devices, and as of this writing, is supporting over 20,000 devices.

A major goal of this project was not to simply replace the Silverlight views with HTML views, but rather to back up and look at the entire ecosystem and develop a solution that helped move the platform forward

With SafeOps, we sought to provide a beautiful and intuitive user interface, as well as a data-rich one. Following the initial launch, the CEO of Loomis called SafeOps "Revolutionary, and the best thing to ever come out of Loomis Engineering". Currently the company is planning to implement this application and others across its European operations.

I serve as Senior Front-End Developer and User Experience Architect.

UTHealth IT Asset Management System (ITAMS)

Following the loss of several assets containing potentially-sensitive data, my team was tasked with centralizing IT asset management and tracking for the university. Working closely with central IT, IT departments at each school and the office of the CIO, I lead a team of developers and delivered a functional MVP in under a month. We utilized agile methodologies in order to deliver features quickly and frequently.

I served as the technical project manager, lead architect and point of contact for stakeholders.
